

## 9-7-2 Tuition Waivers and Deferred Payment

This is a system to waive all or half of tuition or defer payment in the case of students for whom it has been recognized that payment of tuition is extremely difficult due to financial reasons, and who have displayed excellent academic performance, as determined through a screening every half year.

### ■ Eligibility to Apply

Undergraduate students must be eligible for a scholarship from the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO). Graduate students are those who have difficulty in paying tuition fees due to financial reasons and whose academic records are in good standing.

In principle, students who have exceeded the standard term of study are not eligible for the scholarship. However, those who are recognized as having special circumstances are exempted.

### ■ Application Form Distribution and Application Periods

Application form distribution period	1st Semester	Early February until the final day of the application period
	2nd Semester	Early August until the final day of the application period
Application period	1st Semester	March 1 to March 31 (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays) (Applications for deferred payment are accepted until early-April)
	2nd Semester	September 1 to September 30 (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays) (Applications for deferred payment are accepted until early-October)

\* Students who have already paid tuition are not eligible for a waiver or deferred payment.
