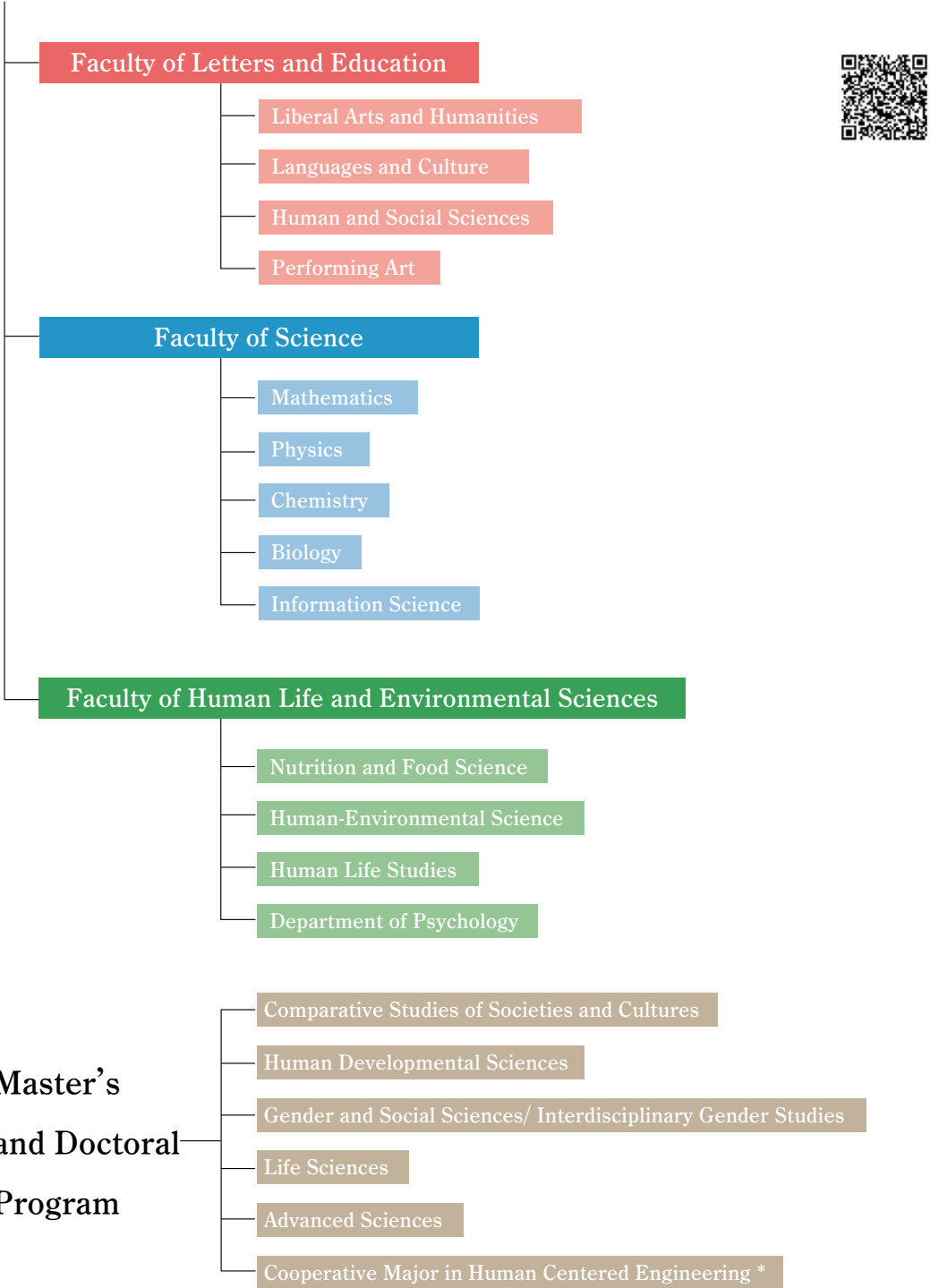

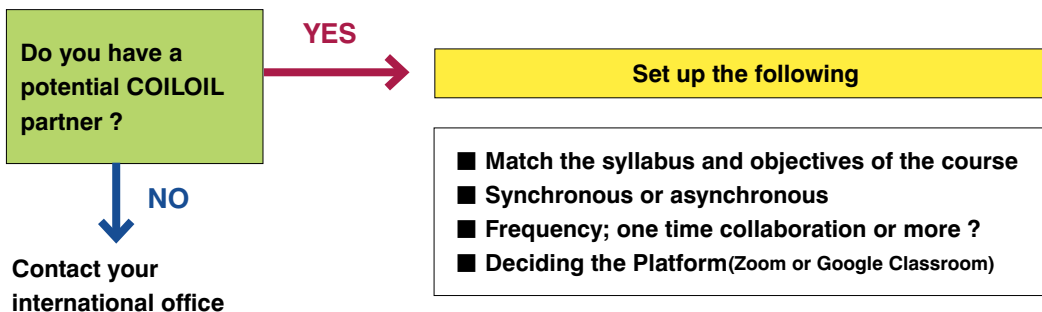

COIL Program

Collaborative Online International Learning (COIL) is an innovative teaching method that facilitates intercultural competency, global awareness, and cross-lingual communication for students to prep are them for multicultural professional environments.

Ochanomizu University aims to (1) provide globally connected educational opportunities, (2) enhance multi-faceted student mobility programs, which incorporate resources from partner institutions and local societies, and (3) contribute toward elimination of educational inequality through COIL for students in developing countries.





Student Exchange Program

If you are enrolled in an overseas university that has an inter-university agreement with us, you may engage in and study at our campus.

Eligibility

Applicants are to be nominated by their home university with an inter-university agreement with Ochanomizu University.

How to Apply

Students can apply through their home university

Period of Stay

Either one or two-straight semester
Spring semester: April–September
Autumn semester: October–March

Financial Support*

Tuition and fees: Application, admission and tuition fee waived
Accommodation: Priority in room allocation in our on-campus dormitory.
Scholarship: An opportunity to receive a JASSO scholarship

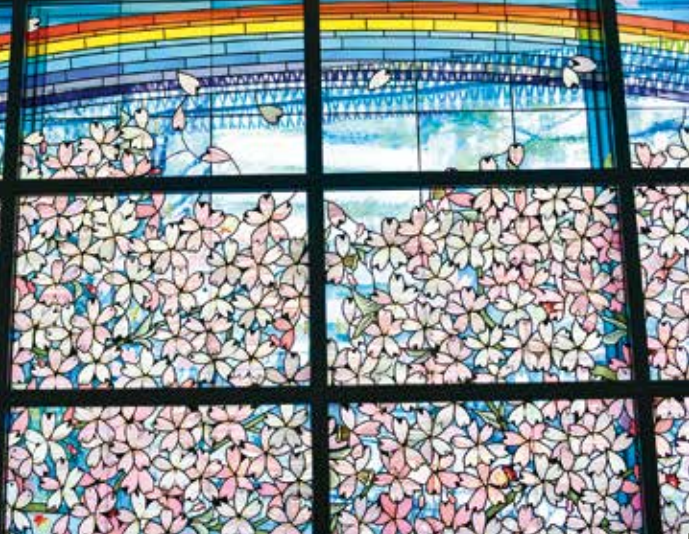
Summer Program

Do I need to contact my prospective supervisor before I apply ?

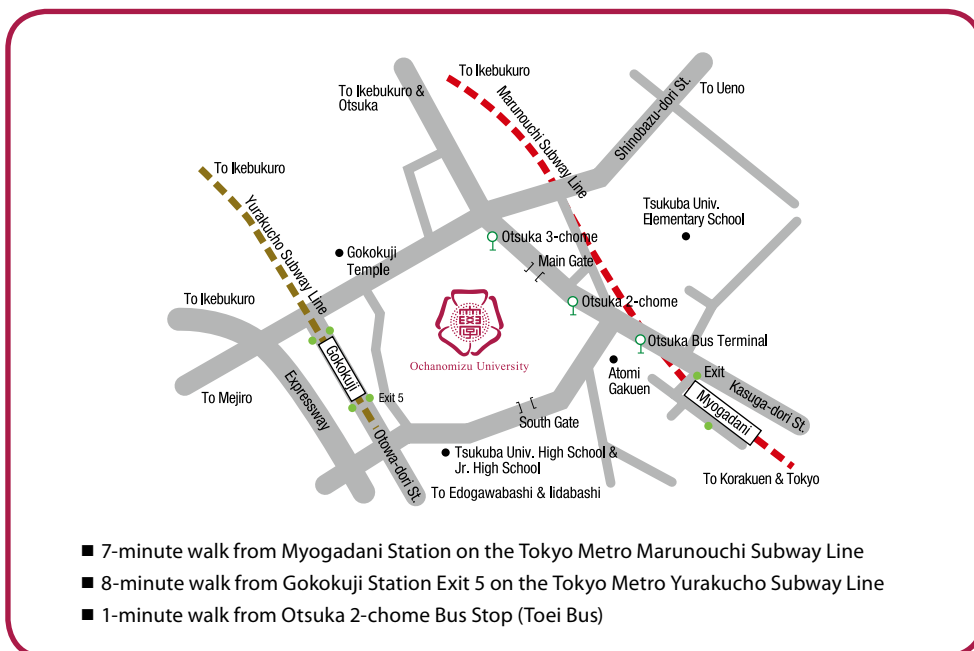
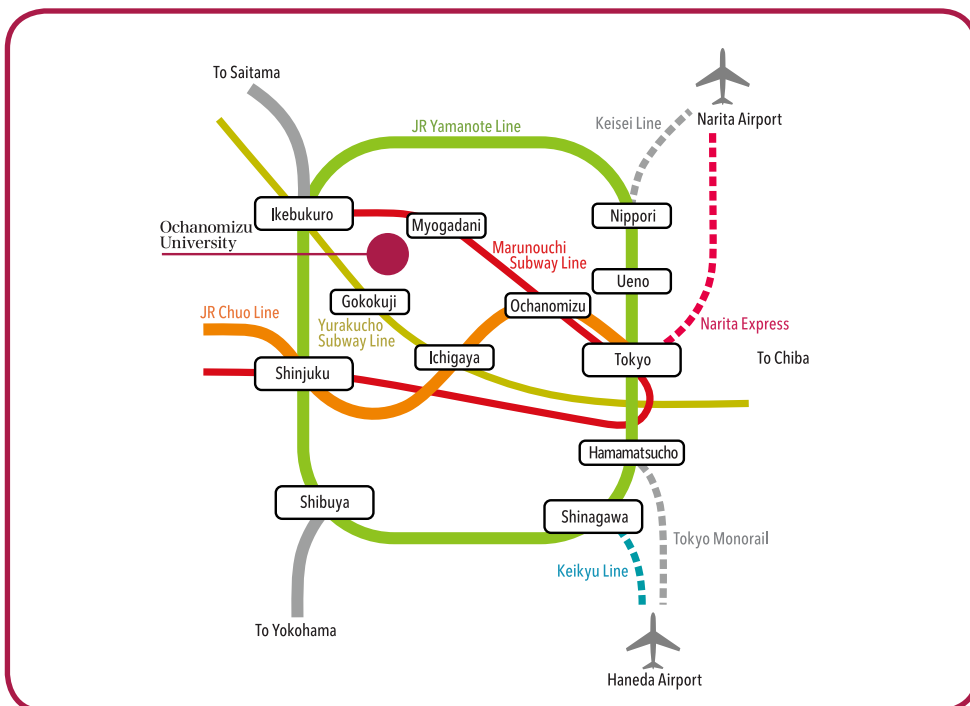
It is highly recommended to contact your prospective supervisor, especially if you are applying as a research or postgraduate student.
