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Established in 1875 as Japan's first national institution of higher education for women, Ochanomizu University will soon celebrate its 150th anniversary. Since its incorporation in 2004, Ochanomizu University has operated under medium-term goals and plans set every six years in accordance with the National University Corporation Act. The fourth medium-term target period began in fiscal 2022, spanning the period through fiscal 2027.

The University is working to nurture global female leaders under its vision for the fourth medium-term, which encompasses three goals: ① the achievement of a society in which women can play active roles, ② the cultivation of human resources who possess comprehensive knowledge and who will transform society, and ③ the advancement of research aimed at achieving a sustainable society.

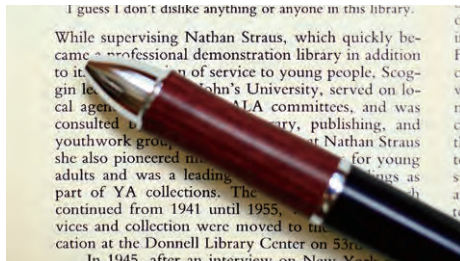

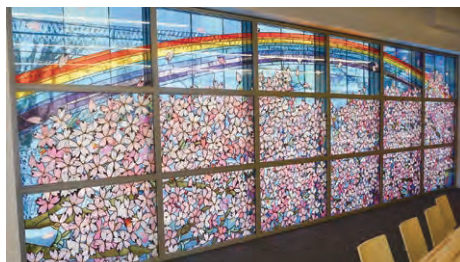

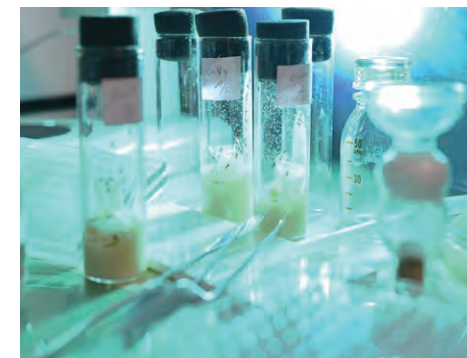


Highest ratio of female researchers selected for Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research among national universities

Introducing the New Faculty of Transdisciplinary Engineering

The Faculty of Transdisciplinary Engineering offers practical training on how to co-create new societies for the future by harnessing data science and incorporating the humanities and social sciences into engineering. It consists of two departments: the Department of Human-Centered Engineering and the Department of Humanities Data Engineering. The Department of Human-Centered Engineering provides students with a foundation in engineering and teaches them about emerging technologies such as human-centered environments and smart materials, and develops their ability to think outside the box and exercise creativity to solve societal problems and co-create a new society. The Department of Humanities Data Engineering digitizes materials in diverse fields such as history, geography, thought, language, literature, and art, applies data science methods to analyze them, and invents and creates culture and value using engineering thinking and technology.

A place for research that transcends conventional academic disciplines

Ochanomizu University has 10 research institutes. The Institute for Gendered Innovations, the Institute for Competency Development, and the Institute for SDGs Promotion were established in the academic year 2022. Ochanomizu University actively communicates information about the value that our research creates on behalf of society.



Institute for Gendered Innovations (IGI)

The idea of gendered innovations promotes the in-depth analysis of sex, gender, and the intersectional differences between these and other attributes, and incorporating them into research and production developments. The social implementation of gendered innovations through research outcomes and developed products may lead to the realization of a society that can achieve various forms of well-being.

The three divisions of IGI – research, innovation, and public relations – interact with each other to promote Gendered Innovations. The research division will examine various issues related to Gendered Innovations. The innovation division will create products and services that apply research results. The public relations division will disseminate information regarding these innovative creations.



Institute for Competency Development

The traits demonstrated by high achievers within society are called competencies. This institute engages in two broad areas of activity for the advancement of competency-based education and research: activities as an academic management organization to improve the competencies of our students, and activities as a research institute to conduct and communicate research concerning competencies spanning early childhood to university education. Through these efforts, the Institute aims to contribute to educational reform at the University and at other institutions nationwide.



Institute for SDGs Promotion

This research institute focuses on food loss and food issues, resource recycling, consumer education, and other issues to advance research aimed at achieving a sustainable society that begins with consumers. Going beyond research and education on these themes in the University and graduate schools, the Institute seeks to take advantage of Ochanomizu University's unique nature as a campus that encompasses affiliated schools to develop integrated SDGs education programs that span from early childhood to university education. As a base for integrating the University's activities for putting the SDGs into practice, the Institute is also in charge of coordinating collaboration with other universities, companies, government bodies, and other partners, and will contribute to the promotion of SDGs-related activities through joint research and internships. Unique initiatives of the Institute include food drives held with affiliated schools as well as study sessions and environmental surveys conducted by the Institute's OCHA-SDGs Student Committee.

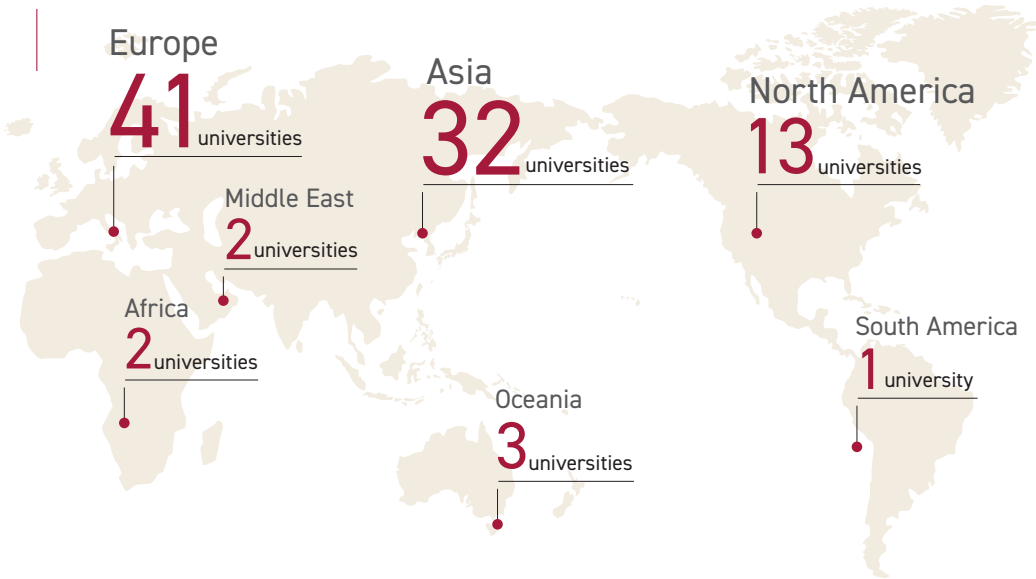

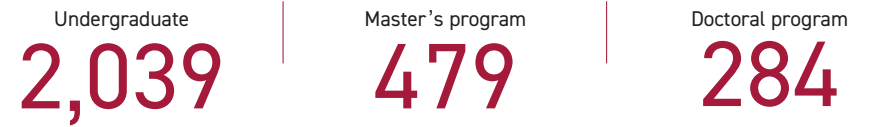

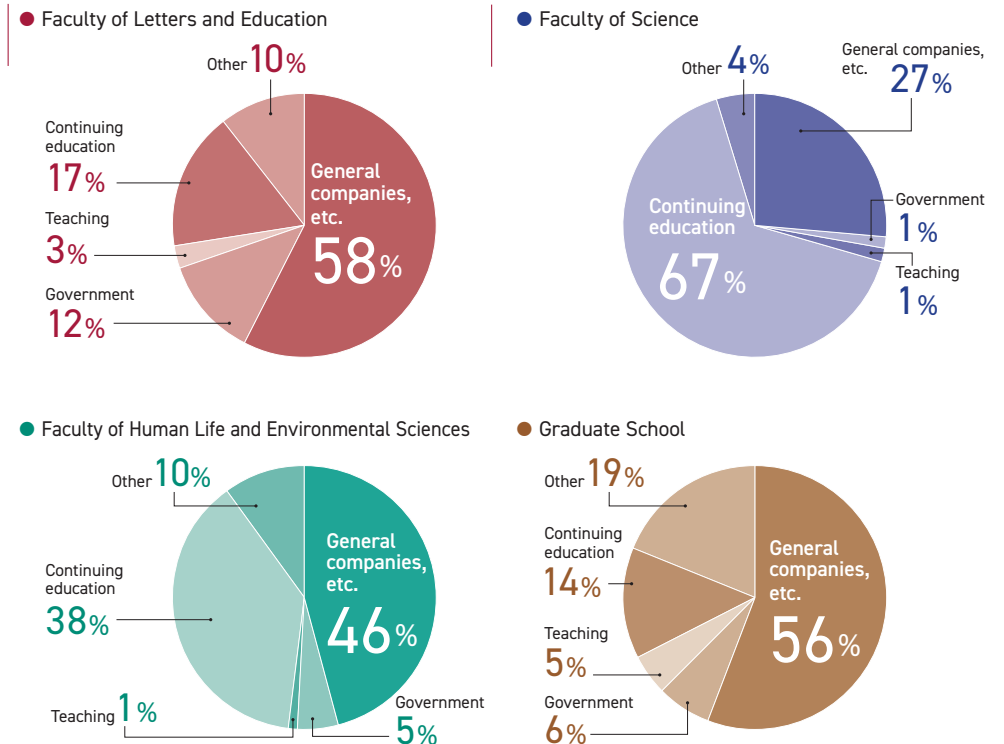
Number of students (as of May 1, 2023)

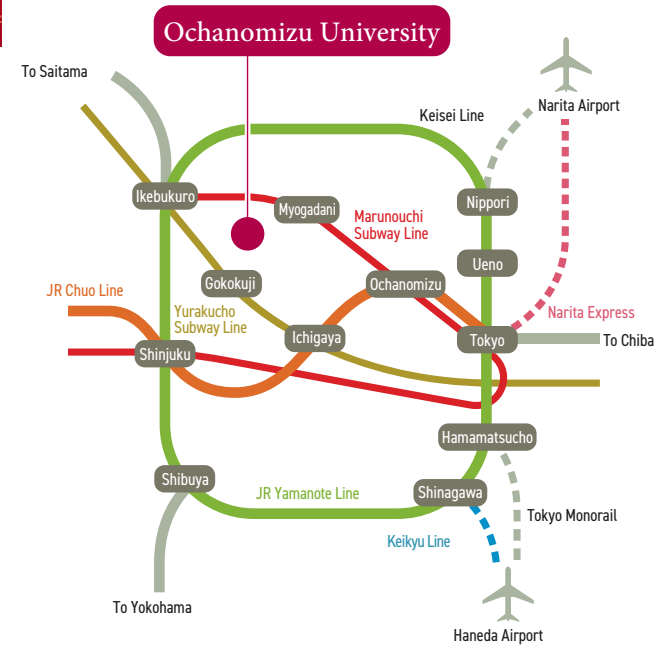

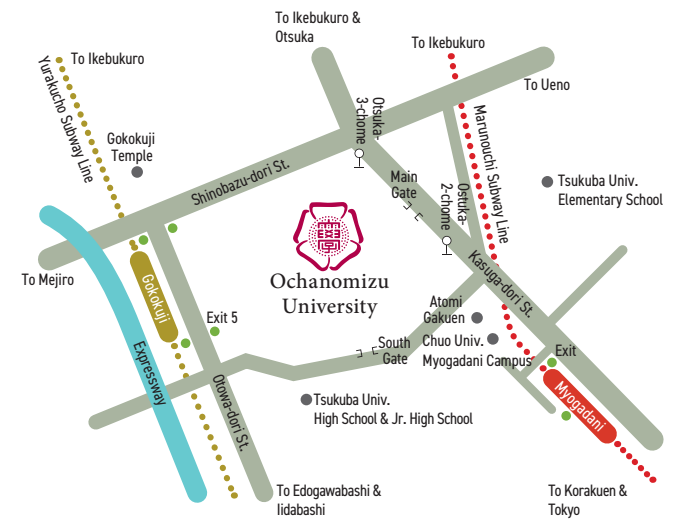
