主題と目標

The aim of this course is to offer basic knowledge on international relations in general and the role of international organizations in it. Giving some weight on the matter of peace and war, the course tries to give students an opportunity to think about what is happening around the world and how international organizations work. Also, this class is envisaged to brush up language skills of participants, esp. vocabulary, listening, speaking, and presentation skills in English. Students planning to study abroad and/or to work in international organizations are encouraged to take the class.

At the end of the semester, students (by an individual or a group) are to make a presentation on a topic related to the class. Students will pick the topic either from those that they have studied in the class or one they choose from other readings. The presentations should be conducted in English for about 15 minutes.
